LEADER OF THE CHAMBER ORCHESTRA

Joachim Neupert.

Born 1955 in Germany. Studied viola with Prof. Enrique Santiago at the Stuttgarter Musikhochschule from 1976 to 1984 gaining an equivalent qualification to a Master of Music degree. During this time he gained experience in leading several Chamber groups and also played in Symphony orchestras including the Young German Philharmonic and South German Radio Symphonic Orchestras.

In 1982 Joachim took leave to study the violin and Suzuki method under Prof Kendall at the University of Southern Illinois, U.S.A. where he also gained a Performance Violin Masters degree.

Joachim is currently teaching violin and viola in Hamilton.

KAREN NEUPERT

Karen's birthplace is Amsterdam, Holland. She majored in the flute while studying at Sweelinck Conservatory. Her interest in Early Music led her to achieve proficiency in two other instruments, the recorder and the viola da gamba.

Karen was a member of the National Dutch Students Orchestra in 1976 and 1977. After completing her studies Karen performed in many Chamber concerts on all three instruments and gave solo recitals both in Holland and Germany.

Since moving to Hamilton two years ago with her husband Joachim, Karen has taken part in several Chamber recitals. This is Karen's second performance with the Waikato Chamber Orchestra. Last year we were privileged to hear her in the Carl Pini concert when she shared the platform with Rosaline Teasdale.

Karen is presently teaching in several private schools in Hamilton.
