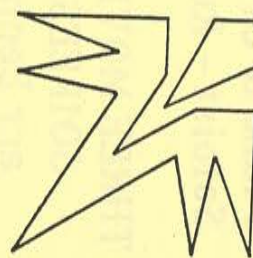
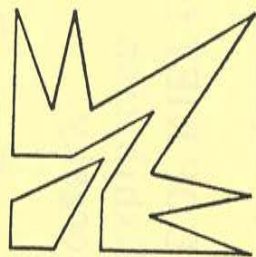

The Count was a splendid soldier and a fiery politician but by a treacherous conspiracy was captured and executed by his political enemies. This Overture preempts the story of the play.
